## CalFresh Replacement Benefits Available

SHASTA COUNTY – Through August 21, CalFresh clients can receive replacement benefits for food purchased with CalFresh that was destroyed in a disaster or household misfortune like the Carr Fire, including food that spoiled because of a mandatory evacuation.

Clients can apply for these replacement benefits through the C4Yourself website, <https://www.c4yourself.com/c4yourself/index.jsp>.

They may also apply in person, by mail or by phone at the following regional offices:

Cal Fresh Replacement application forms will also be available and accepted at the Local Assistance Center (LAC) located at Shasta High School Thursday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

CalFresh, Medi-Cal and other eligibility benefits are not currently available at the Enterprise office, 2757 Churn Creek Rd., or the Shasta Lake office, 4216 Shasta Dam Blvd., due to issues related to the Carr Fire.
