Current Situation:	<p>The Red Bank Fire continues to burn west of Red Bluff. The fire is burning in remote, very steep, rocky terrain. A cold front will challenge firefighters over the weekend as winds will increase and come from variable directions. Weather will improve Sunday with slightly cooler temperatures and better humidity recoveries. The steep terrain and dry, heavy fuels will make containment difficult throughout the fire area.</p> <p>Motorists should drive cautiously and always yield to emergency vehicles that are traveling on and off of the roads and highways. Fire danger remains elevated and everyone should continue to use extreme caution and refrain from daily activities that may spark a wildland fire.
