<b>Current Situation:</b>	<p>The Red Bank Fire continues to burn west of Red Bluff. Firefighters were challenged today by erratic winds in the fire area. The fire remained active throughout the day and will continue to hamper containment efforts into the evening. The weather is expected to improve overnight with cooler temperatures and higher humidities. This weather pattern should allow firefighters to engage the fire more directly and make good progress with containment. Access into the fire line will be difficult based on minimal roads and steep terrain.</p> <p>Motorists should drive cautiously and always yield to emergency vehicles that are traveling on and off of the roads and highways. Fire danger remains elevated and everyone should continue to use extreme caution and refrain from daily activities that may spark a wildland fire. <b>“Ready, Set, Go”</b> is a <b>user-friendly</b> website that shows homeowners step-by-step instructions for hardening their homes and protecting their families from the dangers of wildfires.
