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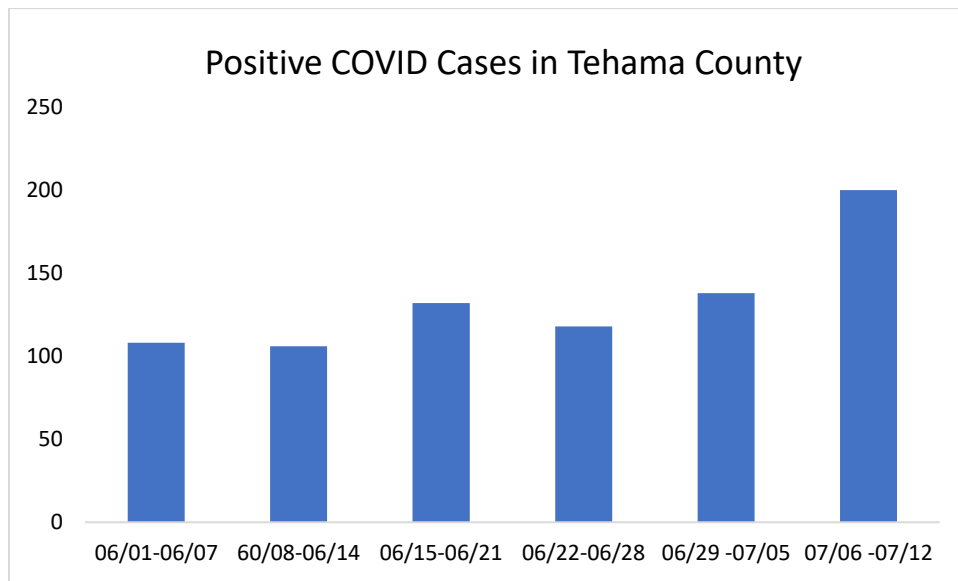
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Public Service Announcement COVID-19 Cases Increasing

During the Summer we can be very busy enjoying a variety of activities with family and friends and COVID 19 can seem like a thing of the past. Unfortunately, the virus is still alive and well in Tehama County. Over the last month we have seen an increase in COVID-19 cases and various Omicron variants like BA.2, BA.4 and BA.5 have been detected. During the week of June 1st to June 7th there were 108 positive COVID cases in Tehama County. By the week of July 6th to July 12th there were a total of 200 cases.



There has also been an increase in hospitalizations in Tehama County. As of July 15th, 2022, there were 10 patients hospitalized for issues related to COVID-19. Of those, 6 were unvaccinated. Vaccines and boosters remain an important tool against COVID-19 infection and help prevent hospitalization. The [American Academy of Pediatrics](#) (AAP), recommends that all eligible individuals aged 6 months and older get the COVID-19 vaccine. Wearing a mask indoors, frequent hand washing, testing before and after a gathering or traveling, and staying home if you are sick are also great ways to prevent COVID-19 infection.

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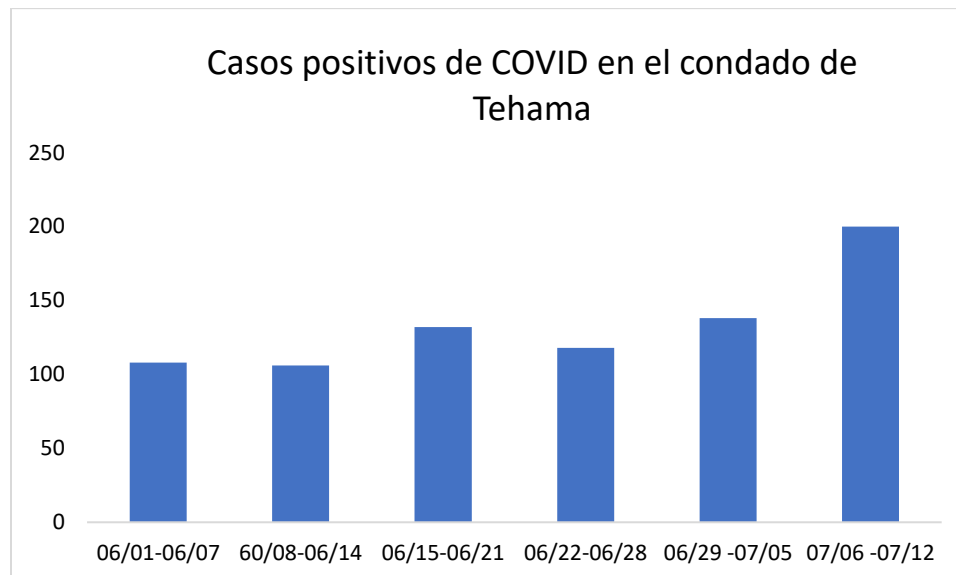
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Anuncio de servicio publico Aumento de casos de COVID-19

Durante el verano podemos estar muy ocupados disfrutando de una variedad de actividades con familiares y amigos y el COVID 19 puede parecer cosa del pasado. Desafortunadamente, el virus todavía está vivo y bien en el condado de Tehama. Durante el último mes hemos visto un aumento en los casos de COVID-19 y se han detectado varias variantes de Omicron como BA.2, BA.4 y BA.5. Durante la semana del 1 al 7 de junio hubo 108 casos positivos de COVID en el condado de Tehama. Para la semana del 6 al 12 de julio había un total de 200 casos.



También ha habido un aumento en las hospitalizaciones en el condado de Tehama. Al 15 de julio de 2022 había 10 pacientes hospitalizados por problemas relacionados con el COVID-19. De ellos, 6 no estaban vacunados. Las vacunas y los refuerzos siguen siendo una herramienta importante contra la infección por COVID-19 y ayudan a prevenir la hospitalización. [American Academy of Pediatrics](#) (AAP) recomienda que todas las personas elegibles de 6 meses en adelante se vacunen contra el COVID-19. Usar una máscara en el interior, lavarse las manos con frecuencia, hacerse pruebas antes y después de una reunión o viajar y quedarse en casa si está enfermo también son excelentes maneras de prevenir la infección por COVID-19.
