ZOGG FIREFIRE DAMAGED TREES

When returning to your home, you may have fire damaged trees on your property.

- Be aware of falling branches
- Loose limbs
- Burned-out stumps and holes
- Unstable trees

If there is uncertainty regarding the damaged trees, avoid the area.

SAFETY MESSAGE – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation orders. A reminder to drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area. If at any time you feel unsafe, please call 911. Residents may experience very smokey conditions as the firefight continues. Smokey conditions can be unhealthful to many people especially children, the elderly, and anyone with respiratory problems.
